

YEAR 13 DRESS CODE

The following will be permitted for Year 13 students. Students may continue to wear the senior uniform if they wish.

Dress code prescribes a neat semi-formal standard of attire. All students must be neatly groomed. Male students must be clean-shaven and no extreme hairstyles or unnatural hair colours are permitted.

Visible Body Piercing is prohibited apart from a single pair of earrings.

Specifically Excluded:

- Screen printed slogans and illustrations promoting liquor or smoking or any material that could cause offence;
- Fabrics of a transparent nature;
- Low cut armholes or necklines;
- Singlet, tank tops, straps etc;
- Entirely black (top and bottom) outfit;
- Jandals and jandal style footwear and backless shoes or sandals;
- Work boots and slippers;
- Beach shorts or running shorts;
- Exceedingly short skirts or shorts;
- Jeans or trousers which have holes in them or are ragged at the edges or bottom.

Acceptable Outfit

- Collared shirt for boys;
- Girls tops with wide shoulder straps or sleeves, high necklines and which cover the top of the lower garment;
- Neat and tidy jeans, trousers, shorts and skirts;
- Solid footwear.

School is equivalent to a place of work and the Year 13 dress standard must reflect that. School is not the place for beach wear, revealing garments or torn and ripped clothing.

In a workshop or laboratory or any other hazardous situation, hair should be tied back and long earrings removed and other jewellery removed.

If this dress code cannot be adhered to, students will be asked to wear the senior uniform.

In all matters of judgment, the Principal shall be the final arbiter.
