Message from Ted Benton, Principal

Dear Parents, Guardians and Caregivers

Tena koutou katoa.

Junior Exams: A reminder to all parents of students in Years 9 and 10 that they have exams from Wednesday, June 18th to Friday, June 20th with school finishing for all students at 12.30pm on Friday, June 20th. We have spoken to the Year 9 students about how to prepare for these exams, reminding them about the importance of having an up-to-date set of notes to study from, about having their Maths and Science workbooks to refer to and about how to study. You can expect to see them doing some study at home. If not, remind them that they should be doing some study and talk about ways to do this. I gave each one of them a sheet on "How to Study". These exams are as much about learning about the process of preparing for and sitting the exams, as about assessing what has been learnt to date. They provide exam practice in preparation for NCEA exams in the years ahead.

Y10 Graduation:- A reminder to parents of Year 10 students that all significant assessments undertaken by students in all subjects generate points which count towards a Graduation Certificate at the end of the year. "Excellence" grades earn more points than "Merit" and so on and some assessments are worth more points than others. This means that assignments being done in a student's own time with a due date are likely to count towards final points and the Junior Exams will also count, as will the exams at the end of the year. In this way we hope to better prepare students for the NCEA environment that they will face in Years 11-13.

Sustainability:- We are continuing to take practical steps towards operating sustainably as a school. We are very proud of the way in which our students have adopted the recycling procedures that we have put in place and the way in which some give extra time to processing that waste and others to working in the gardens about our school, improving our environment through planting and maintaining it. Next steps, which are funding dependent, are our plant nursery, worm farm to process food waste and even more costly, solar power. Any contacts and bright ideas for funding would be much appreciated.

Staff changes:- Matua Rangiheuea leaves us at the end of this term to head off to Wesley College near Pukekohe and Mr Clarke leaves early in Term 3 for Tangaroa College in Otara. Both staff have faced long daily commutes from South Auckland for years and that is their only motivation for seeking change. We wish them well in their new jobs close to home as we search for replacements.

Year 8 Visits:- We have Glenfield Intermediate and Wairau Intermediate Year 8 students visiting us on Monday 23rd and Thursday 26th. We would love some parent volunteers to help prepare lunches for them for both, or either of these days.
